## Reporting WHS Concerns

AHS has developed an Incident Management Process (IMP) for WHS incidents or near misses. An incident is an unplanned event that may or does result in an occupational illness or injury, damage to property or equipment. A near miss is any undesired event or incident that could have ended in injury, illness or loss; first aid or medical attention is not required.
